With this letter, I would like to bring to your attention a couple of important changes regarding vocations that have occurred in our Diocese over the last several months.

As of October 16, 2012, Rev. Francis Agbezuge is no longer pastor of Maidstone, Lashburn, and Delmas. After much reflection and prayer, Fr. Francis came to me with the request to leave the priesthood and embark on a new life. His immediate plans include working in Canada for a time before eventually returning to Ghana. We wish Fr. Francis well; let us continue to pray for him. To fill this vacancy, Fr. Maurice Fiolleau has arranged for a temporary priest to lead the Sunday Eucharistic Celebrations until such a time we are able to find a permanent replacement.

In addition, over the summer months, German Alegria came to the decision to discontinue his endeavours as a seminarian. Therefore, he is no longer considered a seminarian of the Diocese of Prince Albert. Last month, he returned to Mexico to pursue a different course of life. Let us also carry German in our prayers.

May the Lord bless us and continue to guide us as we each strive in the building of His kingdom!
